Policy lines

BOLOGNA

- Adoption of a system of easily readable and comparable degrees;
- Adoption of a system essentially based on two main cycles;
- Establishment of a system of credits;

UDUAL

- Promote a culture of a evaluation and accreditation to guarantee the quality of the services that are offered to society.
- Promote a higher quality of education and articulate the academic actions in different subject areas, creating the Cooperation and Study Organisms which are subject networks.
