# **Foreword**

The **Ninth ASEAN Education Ministers** Meeting (May 2016, in Malaysia), in conjunction with the Third ASEAN Plus Three Education Ministers Meeting, and the Third East Asia Summit of Education **Ministers** hold a number of promises. With the theme "Fostering ASEAN Community of Learners: Empowering Lives through Education," these meetings distinctly emphasized children and young people as the stakeholders and collective cooperation in education in ASEAN and among the Member States. The Ministers also affirmed the important role of education in promoting a better quality of life for children and young people, and in providing them with an opportunity to participate in and benefit from the realization of a prosperous ASEAN Community 2025. They highlighted the need to deepen the scope of education partnership among ASEAN Member States towards the development of a more coordinated, cohesive and coherent ASEAN position and contribution to global education issues. The ASEAN Work Plan on Education 2016-2020 which they adopted hopes to unify all collaboration efforts on education with ASEAN Dialogue Partners and international organizations and other entities that support ASEAN.

The ASEAN Work Plan on Education focuses on eight areas:

- ASEAN awareness through strengthening Southeast Asian history and indigenous knowledge
- quality and access to basic education for all especially the marginalized groups
- information and communication technologies in education
- technical and vocational education and training (TVET) and lifelong learning
- Education for Sustainable Development (ESD)
- higher education development and quality assurance mechanisms
- university-industry partnership
- capacity building for teachers and the education community.

The International Association of Universities (IAU) shares several of these focus areas, notably the focus on indigenous knowledge, quality, access and ESD among others. The Association also applauds the promotion of academic mobility and the Ministers' endorsement of the ASEAN

Qualifications Reference Framework (AQRF) Governance and Structure, and the plans to institutionalize the AQRF processes on a voluntary basis at the national and regional levels. All these will help enhance quality, credit transfer and student mobility, as well as university collaboration and people-to-people connectivity which are all crucial in realigning the diverse education systems and opportunities, as well as creating a more coordinated, cohesive and coherent ASEAN.

The IAU is particularly pleased to note that the Meeting approved the revised Charter of the ASEAN University Network (AUN), better aligned with the new developments in ASEAN. The AUN and IAU have been collaborating as partners in advancing the role of education regionally and worldwide by building a committed community of learners. Both associations are aware of the importance of the various networks and projects that exist in the region, including: AUN Southeast Asia Engineering Education Development Network (AUN/SEED-Net), ASEAN-EU Cooperation on Education: EU Support to Higher Education in ASEAN Region (SHARE), GIZ **Regional** Cooperation Programme to Improve the Training of TVET Personnel (RECOTVET), Fulbright U.S.-ASEAN Initiative, Connecting the Mekong through Education and Training (COMET).

With this inaugural publication which attempts to provide as much information as possible about the higher education systems and institutions in the ASEAN region in a comprehensive and reliable manner, IAU hopes to help facilitate deeper education cooperation on the basis of accurate data.





# **ASEAN and its Member States**



The **Association of Southeast Asian Nations**, or ASEAN, was established on 8 August 1967 in Bangkok, Thailand, with the signing of the ASEAN Declaration (Bangkok Declaration) by Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore and Thailand. Brunei Darussalam joined in 1984, Vietnam in 1995, Lao PDR and Myanmar in 1997, and Cambodia in 1999, creating what is today the ten Member States of ASEAN.

As set out in the ASEAN Declaration, the aims and purposes of ASEAN are:

1. To accelerate the economic growth, social progress and cultural development in the region through joint endeavours in the spirit of equality and partnership in order to strengthen the foundation for a prosperous and peaceful community of Southeast Asian Nations:

- To promote regional peace and stability through abiding respect for justice and the rule of law in the relationship among countries of the region and adherence to the principles of the United Nations Charter;
- 3. To promote active collaboration and mutual assistance on matters of common interest in the economic, social, cultural, technical, scientific and administrative fields:
- Asian 4. To provide assistance to each other in the form of training and research facilities in the educational, professional, technical and administrative spheres;
  - 5. To collaborate more effectively for the greater utilisation of their agriculture and industries, the expansion of their trade, including the study of the problems of international commodity trade, the improvement of their transportation and communications facilities and the raising of the living standards of their peoples;
  - 6. To promote Southeast Asian studies; and
  - 7. To maintain close and beneficial cooperation with existing international and regional organisations with similar aims and purposes, and explore all avenues for even closer cooperation among themselves.

# **Kuala Lumpur Declaration on Higher Education**



In the 27th ASEAN Summit 2015 in Malaysia, the meeting had adopted the **Kuala Lumpur Declaration** on **Higher Education** and had agreed to:

- acknowledge the critical importance of higher education as one of the catalysts in accelerating ASEAN's economic, political and sociocultural development agenda
- II. uphold quality in the provision of higher education across all member states:
- III. enhance academic contribution of ASEAN higher education within the global academic community;
- IV. embrace diversity and solidarity of the ASEAN Community through enhanced intra-ASEAN mobility of students and scholars;
- V. contribute to the promotion of peace, prosperity, resilience, and vibrancy of ASEAN through synergised collaboration between the academia, industry, government and community:
- VI. foster sustainable local community development through participation of

- youth, professionals and volunteers in entrepreneurial endeavours;
- Community with critical thinking capability and skill through capacity building offered by higher education institutions within ASEAN, such as opportunities for lifelong learning, technical and vocational education and training (TVET), online and blended learning, postgraduate education, transnational education and other flexible learning options;
- VIII. contribute to sustainable development through academic programmes, research, community development and stakeholder engagement:
- X. increase visibility of ASEAN globally through increased thought leadership in various disciplines of higher education at regional and international levels:

for the strengthening of the region through the promotion of human resource development and higher education. This aspiration has led to the signing of the Charter of the ASEAN University Network and thus the establishment of ASEAN University Network (AUN) in November 1995 with the AUN Secretariat established in Bangkok, Thailand. Since its establishment, AUN, the network of leading universities, has been serving as ASEAN's implementing agency in the field of higher education for the region's move towards ASEAN Community.

In terms of organisational structure, the structure can be categorised into 3 levels.

- Policy level consists of the AUN Board of Trustees (AUN-BOT).
- Implementing level consists of AUN Member Universities who participate and implement the programmes and activities under AUN. Currently, AUN membership

has extended to 30 leading universities throughout ASEAN and the ASEAN+3 University Network, which includes 10 universities from China, Japan and Korea, was established in 2012.

• Coordinating and monitoring level is served by AUN Secretariat.

The functions of the **AUN Secretariat** also cover planning, organising, coordinating, monitoring and evaluating programmes and activities. The AUN Secretariat's tasks also include developing innovations and proposal for cooperation under AUN as well as to develop plans and mechanisms for sourcing and generating funds for self-reliant and self-sustaining operation of AUN.

AUN works closely with ASEAN Secretariat in reporting progress and proposing initiatives for further intra-regional and inter-regional cooperation in higher education.

#### Recent Laws/Decrees and Strategic Plans in HE: students can proceed to the pre-university

Strategic Plan 2012-2017

Brunei Darussalam is the smallest ASEAN country in terms of population, with only 417,400 people living in this small state. The country is considered a high income (non-OECD) country by the World Bank, ranked second highest in the Human Development Index in the region.

The education system is based on the Education Act of 2003. The Ministry of Education's Strategic Plan **2012-2017** is part of 'Brunei Vision 2035'. It aims at enhancing the structures of the education system and therefore make the education system in Brunei Darussalam one of the best worldwide

Children enter the education system at the age of 5 and stay at the pre-school level for one year. Primary education lasts six years and is divided into lower (Year 1 to Year 3) and upper (Year 4 to Year 6) primary education. At the end of Year 6, pupils sit for the Primary School Assessment or Penilaian Sekolah Rendah (PSR). In secondary education, the majority of students will spend five years (four years for highly capable students) before they can take the Brunei-Cambridge General Certificate of Education (GCE) O-level examinations at the end of Year 10 or Year 11. Upon completion of their secondary education,


level (Sixth Form Level), pursue vocational education in a technical or an engineering Education Act (2003) college, or seek employment.

> To enter tertiary level education, students must have completed 'A' level courses with adequate and relevant passes. education is provided by universities, one polytechnic, institutes, and colleges. It is offered at both public and private institutions.

> The **higher education system** is divided into three levels, according to qualifications as follows: Bachelor, Master and Doctorate. The Brunei Darussalam National Accreditation Council, a unit under the Ministry of Education, is in charge of assessing the qualifications awarded by local and overseas higher education institutions/universities.



**Cambodia** was the last country to join ASEAN in 1999. According to the World Bank it is a Low Income country. Cambodia shares boarders with Lao PDR, Thailand and Vietnam. 37 Higher Education Institutions can be found in Cambodia, most of them in the capital Phnom Penh. Cambodia is one of the least developed countries in the world according to the Human Development Index. It further features only an enrolment ratio in tertiary education of 16%, ranking on the second to last place in ASEAN.


Primary education (1st Phumaseksar) lasts for six years. Secondary education (2nd Phumaseksar) is divided into two three-year cycles: lower secondary and upper secondary. Primary and lower-secondary education are compulsory.

Higher education is the third level (3rd Phumasekar) of education. It falls under the responsibility of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport. It is composed of two types of institutions: universities and institutes that can be public or private.

The Accreditation Committee was created to develop the standards of education and to assess higher education quality.

Teacher education is separated into lower and upper secondary education. While teachers for lower secondary education can receive training at regional teacher training centres, teachers for upper secondary education need a bachelor's degree first, after which they can go to the National Institute of Education for a diploma of education or upper secondary school teacher.

National Education Systems Law No. 20 (2003) Higher Education Act (2012)

**Indonesia** is not only the country with the biggest population in ASEAN, but also the fourth most populous country in the world making it the country with the biggest Muslim population. The country is spread out over many diverse islands, with the capital Jakarta on the main island Java.

Basic education in Indonesia consists of 9 years of compulsory education. Primary education lasts for six years. Secondary education is divided into junior, senior and vocational/technical education. Junior secondary school covers three years and is part of the basic general education programme also covering the six years of primary education. Senior secondary school also covers three years. There are several types of secondary schools: general, Islamic and vocational. In the third year of senior secondary school, students choose between



**Higher education** is mainly offered at private higher education institutions. It consists in universities (comprehensive set of disciplines), institutes (single field of discipline), academies (Sciences and Humanities), and polytechnics (Engineering). The latest two are vocational institutions.

The higher education **quality assurance system** comprises internal quality assurance conducted by the higher education institution and external quality assurance through accreditation. The accreditation of higher education institutions is conducted by the National Accreditation Board for Higher Education.

# Lao People's Democratic Republic

is the only landlocked country in ASEAN. It joined the Association in 1997 together with Myanmar. Only 6.6 million people are living in Lao PDR, making it one of the least populated countries in the region compared to its size.

**Primary education** lasts for five years, starts at 6 years of age and is compulsory. **Secondary education** lasts for 7 years and is divided into lower secondary and upper secondary. At the end of lower **secondary school**, pupils sit for the Lower Secondary School Diploma and at the end of upper secondary school they sit for the Upper Secondary School Diploma.


**Higher education** is provided by universities, technical and professional institutes, and teacher training colleges. Higher education institutions are managed by the government. They fall under the responsibility of the Ministry of Education or, in the case of the University of Health Sciences, the Ministry of Health.

All programmes offered at universities are officially recognized and accredited by the

**Ministry of Education**. Credit transfers are subject to direct agreement between institutions.

Lao PDR offers various sorts of Diplomas to graduates of the secondary school. Those non-university degrees last two to five year. It is also the only country that does not normally offer doctoral education. Doctoral education is only offers in collaboration with foreign universities in very specific disciplines.

**Malaysia** consist of two parts, the smaller one is home to its capital Kuala Lumpur, while the bigger one is part of the Borneo. Malaysia recently published its **Education Blueprint**, aiming at changing and improving its education system by 2025.

**Primary education** lasts for six years and is compulsory. **secondary education** covers five years, divided into two stages: lower and upper. Upon completion of secondary education, students can opt to pursue 2 years of **post-secondary education** which is the university entrance preparatory course. At the end of the pre-university course, pupils take the Sijil Tinggi Pelajaran Malaysia.


**Higher education** is provided by universities, polytechnics, community colleges and colleges. There are both public and a wide variety of private higher

education institutions. The Ministry of Education supervises the education policy in the country.

The Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA) is responsible for quality assurance of higher education. MQA assures programmes through two distinct processes: (1) Provisional accreditation and (2) Accreditation: formal recognition that the certificates, diplomas and degrees awarded by the higher education institution are in accordance with the set standards.




**Myanmar** joined ASEAN 1997, one year before the University Education law from 1973 was amended. Since then, Myanmar has undergone many changes and is considered having a low Human Developing Index rank of 148 out of 185, separating it by 127 places to Singapore, who has the highest HDI in ASEAN. Myanmar has further the lowest gross enrolment ratio for tertiary education of the whole ASEAN.

**Primary education**, the first stage of basic education is, in principle, compulsory. It lasts for five years. **Secondary education** is divided into middle schools and high schools and lasts for six years.

**Higher education** is provided by military universities, universities and institutes. They are all State institutions. Most of them are under the control of the Ministry of Education. They are independent units. Each university has an academic and an administrative board. National policies are established by the Universities' Central Council and the Council of University Academic Bodies which are chaired by the Minister of Education. All institutions are State-financed. A nominal fee is charged for studies.

Myanmar offers a wide range of tertiary level education, adapting the length of each qualification to the needs of the subject. It further offers many certificates who are less time consuming.


schools; the Technical Education and Skills Development. The CHED grants the authority to operate and is in charge of the recognition of higher education institutions' programmes. Quality assurance is conducted through the Institutional Quality Assurance through Monitoring and Evaluation (IQuAME) and by one of the 4 accrediting agencies under the umbrella of the Federation of Accrediting Agency of the Philippines (FAAP).

**The Philippines** are home to the most Higher Education Institutions in ASEAN. It is further the only country not having any land boarders with one of the other ASEAN countries. Due to colonial times, the Higher Education System is influenced by the Spanish, British and American system.

Starting from school year 2011-2012 (with full implementation to be realized in 2017), the Philippines is shifting from 10 years of **primary and secondary education** to compulsory (and free of charge in public schools) one year of Kindergarten + 12 years of basic education composed of 6 years of primary education, 4 years of junior high school and 2 years of senior high school.

**Higher education** is provided by public and private universities and colleges. The State universities and colleges (SUCs) on which charters have been conferred are autonomous. In terms of enrolment, a



**Singapore** is in size by far the smallest ASEAN state, yet it has also the strongest economic force, ranging on rank eleven in the Human Development Index. Together with Brunei Darussalam it is considered High Income (nonOECD) by the World Bank. Singapore's Education system is worldwide recognised and is considered one of the best, due to its lifelong learning approach.


**Primary education** lasts for six years and is compulsory. Secondary school pupils are placed in the Special, Express, Normal (Academic) or Normal (Technical) course according to how they performed at the Primary School-leaving Examination (PSLE). Students who complete secondary **education** may proceed to pre-university education at the Junior Colleges/Centralised Institutes or pursue studies at the ITE or the Polytechnics. Pre-university education prepares students for the GCE A-Level examination at the end of the two-year Junior College or three-year Centralised Institute course.

**Post-secondary education** is provided by three kinds of institutions: universities, polytechnics, and the Institute of Technical

Education (ITE). There are three publicly-funded universities and five polytechnics.


The Ministry of Education has put in place distinctive quality assurance frameworks (QAFs) for its autonomous Universities, Polytechnics, Institute of Technical Education and 2 publicly-funded private arts institutions. The QAFs seek to encourage institutions' continual self-learning, quality enhancement and development, as well as to ensure accountability for the use of public funds. Each institution is validated every 5 years and involves an institutional self-assessment, an external validation by an external review panel (comprising local and international academics and industry leaders), and followup initiatives by the institutions after the external validation.


**Thailand** is in the heart of ASEAN, bordering Malaysia, Myanmar, Lao PDR, and Cambodia. Most of the inter-Asian organisations are located in Bangkok, **Thailand's capital. It is a Middle Income** Country according to the World Bank.

Formal education is divided into two levels basic education and higher education. **Basic Education** is free of charge in public schools and divided into three levels (pre-primary, primary and secondary). It follows a 6-3-3 structure where six-year primary (Prathom 1 to 6) and three-year lower **secondary education** (Mathayom 1 to 3) are compulsory. At the **upper secondary** level (Mathayom 4 to 6), schools are divided into 2 major tracks: general (academic), and vocational. At the end of upper secondary school pupils sit for the Upper Secondary School Certificate (Mattayom Suksa 6).

**Higher Education** is provided at 150 institutions, based on a 15 year long range plan on HE started in 2008. Higher education is divided into two levels; diploma and degree

**Vietnam** embraces Lao PDR and Cambodia and shares a boarder with China. According to the World Bank is Vietnam a Lower Middle Income Country.


**Primary education** lasts for five years leading to the Certificate of Primary Education. Secondary school education is divided into two cycles: basic secondary and specialized secondary school. Admission to upper secondary school requires passing a competitive entrance examination. There is also technical and vocational secondary education. Secondary technical schools provide students with an intermediate level of technical skills. Students are enrolled in vocational training schools at two levels: at the lower level, the duration of courses ranges from less than a year to three years. At the upper secondary level, three to four-year courses are offered. Upon graduation, students obtain a diploma. At the end of secondary education, pupils sit for the Bang Tot Nghiep Pho Thong examination administered by the MoET. They then have to pass an entrance examination to know where they will be enrolled.

Vietnam is the only country in ASEAN having two different systems leading to a Bachelor degree: the longer and also to further leading **Dai Hoc** and the **Cao Dang**. **Higher education** is provided by universities and undergraduate schools. It is offered at both public and private

institutions. All secondary and higher institutions come under the supervision of the **Ministry of Education and Training** (MoET), with the exception of the 2 national universities, which come under the supervision of the Prime Minister and regional undergraduate schools, which come under the supervision of the provincial authorities.


