Main focus for the internship

“Higher Education and Research for Sustainable Development (HESD)” is one of the key priority areas of work of the IAU since the early 90s when the [IAU Kyoto Declaration](#) was adopted.

More recently, since the adoption of the *UN Agenda 2030 -Transforming our world* and the associated sustainable development Goals (the 17 SDGs), higher education is mobilised further to contribute significantly to promoting sustainable development.

To support IAU Members’ initiatives and to foster networking and cooperation in support of sustainable development, IAU developed and maintains the [global portal on HESD](#), as well as created the **“IAU Global Cluster on HESD”**.

Reporting directly to the IAU Programme Officer, the successful candidate will be invited to work on a series of projects developed by the IAU and in particular the IAU driven initiatives in the field of *Higher Education and Research for Sustainable Development* (HESD).

Work assignments will include:

- content creation and technical development of the **IAU Global Portal on Higher Education for Sustainable Development** (www.iau-hesd.net)
- support with communication with the **IAU HESD Cluster Network** and partners,
- liaising with higher education institutions from around the world,
- general preparation of HESD projects, including assistance with the preparation of (virtual) events,
- desk-based research and communication related tasks.

Location of the Internship: IAU at UNESCO House, 1, rue Miollis, Paris, France

Start month: October 2023 (or slightly earlier)

Duration: 4 to 6 months; 35 h/week - fulltime (remuneration according to French student internship law: 4,05 €/h)

Profile:

- **Desired educational background:** Social Sciences, Languages, with knowledge and interest in themes related to sustainable development and higher education
- **Enrolled as a student** in the final year of undergrad studies or postgraduate level (MA)
- Previous internship experience in an international team an asset

Required skills:

- Excellent communication and drafting skills
- Ability to work independently on various tasks, and report back to the Programme Officer
- Good knowledge of Microsoft Word; Excel; previous experience with Content Management Systems (CMS- Drupal); communication tools would be an asset
- Language requirements: excellent level of English, and good knowledge of French or another UN language would be an asset
